CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS 2022

1. Crawling Valley Campground is privately owned and operated. Please use respect and follow these rules when camping at Crawling Valley for everyone's enjoyment. Please keep your property on your site; CVRS is not responsible for lost or stolen items. **CVRS is not responsible for any injury to, loss of, or damage to the personal property of the camper.**
2. Camping is permitted on gravel pads only. **Do not erect anything on the grass.**
3. Irrigation starts at midnight. Anything left on the grass will get wet. Because of irrigation, lines please check with us before driving any pegs into the grass. CVRS will not be responsible for water damage to personal property. Do not park your camper or put your slide outs over the grass.
4. Maximum per site (1) trailers and one (1) free tent, or two (2) tents. Maximum stay is fourteen (14) nights then you have to leave the campground for two (2) nights. Power sites are \$40.00 and tenting sites are \$30.00 per night per unit.
5. NO thumping music allowed at anytime. Quiet time is between 11pm to 7am. During quiet time, your music should not travel beyond your site. No loud voices, barking dogs, idling vehicles etc during this time.
6. Dogs have to be tied on a short leash at all times while on campground property. A maximum of two (2) dogs per unit. No vicious dogs allowed in campground including **Pitt Bulls, Bullmastiffs and Rottweiler's**. Owners are responsible for clean up after his/her pet.
7. Fireworks are not permitted in the campground. Campfires are to be supervised by an adult and must be contained in fire pits. We will extinguish any extreme or unwatched campfires.
8. Keep dogs off beach area. No lifeguard on duty for swimming area. Use at your own risk.
9. Crawling Valley has the right, and will lock the entry gate from 11:00pm to 7:00am. Vehicles can leave but cannot enter during quiet time. If there is an emergency, contact the caretaker on duty to open the gate.
10. Alcohol is permitted in your campsite only. Alcohol is not permitted off site in any public areas.
11. No off-road vehicles permitted in camp boundaries. Any and all electric powered miniature vehicles and powered bicycles are not permitted in the campground with the exception of mobility aids. All vehicles, boat trailers etc. are to be parked in parking lots or on the campsite, nothing can be parked on the grass. Campground speed is 15km per hour.
12. Boat slips are \$10.00 per day please pay before you park. The Marina is a NO WAKE ZONE please use respect. Two (2) hour maximum free parking at number 1 set of docks. Please note it is unlawful to ride in your boat to and from the boat launch. Boaters speed 10km per hour within thirty (30) meters from shore. Please do not enter swimming area.
13. Please drop your garbage off at the dumpsters provided and help us to keep the campground clean by not littering.
14. Please do not cut down, damage, or remove any tree or plant life from Crawling Valley Campground.
15. When you are assigned a site, you are responsible for any damages you cause to that site or any property or equipment at Crawling Valley. Please do not bring any slingshots, pellet guns etc. into Crawling Valley Campground. You are responsible for your guests and should tell them to leave if they are not following the rules.
16. The rules are so that everyone can come and enjoy a good camping experience at Crawling Valley. Any disregard for the rules and your campsite rental may be terminated immediately without refund. The campsite must be vacated immediately. Your privileges will be suspended and the Boards decision is final.

Cooperation by all campers will allow for everyone to have a good camping experience.
